

The Prattauga Art Guild office is located in the Prattville Creative Arts Center and Gallery at 342 South Chestnut Street behind City Hall in historic Downtown Prattville. The Gallery features works by members of the Prattauga Art Guild and guest artists, with exhibits changing throughout the year.

The Gallery includes a permanent collection featuring works by internationally known artists, Charlie "Tin Man" Lucas and The Artist Nall; Russell Everett, artist and stone sculptor of Troy University; and internationally recognized quilt artist, Yvonne Wells of Tuscaloosa; as well as other national, regional and local artists.

Art classes and workshops for children and adults are offered in a variety of media at the Creative Arts Center. Award winning artists and art teachers offer classes in painting, drawing, clay, and more.

Through its various exhibits and programs, the Prattauga Art Guild brings fine arts and art education to Prattville and the River Region. As a part of the Prattville Creative and Performing Arts Council, the Art Guild is funded by the City of Prattville.

The Art Guild meets the second Tuesday of each month, except July, at 6:00pm at the Prattville Creative Arts Center. Membership is open to all artists and non-artists 18 years and older who are no longer enrolled in high school.

- Members are required to remit 20% commission to the City of Prattville after each sale at the Gallery or PAG event. Members are responsible for their own taxes.

- Members are responsible for keeping the gallery open during regularly scheduled gallery hours and to keep the gallery clean and neat.
- In order to be a voting member of PAG, one must have attended at least three (3) regular monthly meetings during the prior year.
