



# Proclamation

By the Mayor of Prattville, Alabama

WHEREAS, there are 18 employees in the Sanitation Department; 12 drivers, 1 service maintenance workers, 1 equipment operator, 2 foremen, 1 office manager, and 1 sanitation director that provide weekly service to the entire City of Prattville; and

WHEREAS, our Clean City Professionals work in a variety of weather conditions, maintain a positive attitude, and take tremendous pride in their work as they keep the City of Prattville beautiful; and

WHEREAS, the employees of the Sanitation Department complete approximately 13,209 Residential and 299 Commercial collections each year. On a yearly basis, they collect over 54,000 yards of trash and over 10,500 tons of garbage; and

WHEREAS, recycling is still on the forefront in the City of Prattville. Over 250 tons of cardboard were recycled last year. This initiative keeps these items out of our landfills and helps reduce costs. The 2019 partnership with Re-Power South, enhanced the opportunity to keep recyclable products out of our landfills and allows 100% citywide participation. Our Clean City Professionals continue to keep our city environment friendly; and

WHEREAS, our clean City Professionals have some of the most direct contact with our citizens as they collect routes throughout the city each week, and they play a vital role in the health of our community. I will continue to promote this division as our Clean City Professionals, and I truly appreciate their continuous efforts to keep our community beautiful.
