## KNOW YOUR VICTIMS' RIGHTS

In accordance with the Alabama Victims' Rights Laws statute (Section 15-23-62), the Prattville Police Department and all other law enforcement agencies in Alabama are required to provide victims of crime with the information referenced below within 72 hours after initial contact, unless the victim is unavailable or incapacitated as result of a crime committed against them:

1. The availability of emergency and crisis services.
2. The availability of violent crime victims' compensation benefits and the name, address, and telephone number of the Alabama Crime Victims Compensation Commission.
3. The name of the law enforcement officer and telephone number of the law enforcement agency with the following statement attached: "If within 60 days you are not notified of an arrest in your case, you may call the telephone number of the law enforcement agency for the status of the case."
4. The procedural steps involved in criminal prosecution.
5. The rights authorized by the Alabama Constitution on rights of victims, including a form to invoke these rights.
6. The existence and eligibility requirements of restitution and compensation pursuant to Section 15-18-65 et. seq. and Section 15-23-1 et. seq.
7. A recommended procedure if the victim is subjected to threats or intimidation.
8. The name and telephone number of the office of the prosecuting attorney to contact for further information.

## PROTECTION ORDERS

Under the Alabama Protection from Abuse (PFA) Act, you may apply for a civil protective order which can include, but not limited to:

- \* Restrain an abuser from committing or threatening to commit abuse to you and/or your children.
- \* Remove an abuser from your residence, regardless of who owns the residence
- \* Order an abuser from entering your home, school, business, place of employment or other designated places.
- \* Award you temporary custody of any minor children and establish reasonable visitation rights.
- \* Other relief as necessary to provide you safety and protection. Emergency temporary protection orders may be requested if needed.

Forms may be obtained at the Circuit Clerk's office in each county. Orders issued under this act are civil in nature, temporary and only effective for one year. To be effective, it must be served on the abuser. If the abuser violates the order after being served, he/she may be punished for civil contempt and/or criminal contempt of court, which may result in a fine and/or jail.
